

## **Basic Human Needs Grants**

**Catholic Charities of the Dioceses of Santa Rosa:** \$5,000 for shelter supplies at the Family Support Center

**Children's Village of Sonoma County:** \$5,000 to purchase food that helps sustain a healthy diet for foster children

**Cloverdale Community Outreach Committee:** \$5,000 to provide shelter, food and transportation vouchers, sleeping bags and laundry tokens for homeless persons

**Episcopal Senior Communities:** \$5,000 to provide emergency financial support to low income seniors for food and rental and utility assistance

**Friends In Sonoma Helping:** \$5,000 to provide rental assistance to families at risk of becoming homeless

**Friends Outside in Sonoma County:** \$5,000 to support providing assistance in obtaining food, shelter, clothing and transportation for inmates being released from the Sonoma County Jail

## Education Grants
